- As we gather for this study, we recognize that many in our community are experiencing a mix of emotions.
- For the Black community, elections carry an absorbent amount of weight.
   Elections represent the ongoing struggle for equality, justice, and recognition in a country where we have fought for centuries to have our voices heard and our lives valued.
- The reality of this presidential outcome compels us to raise deep questions about the future and about our role in shaping it.
- The title of this study is drawn from Dr. King's poignant question he raised in 1967. Dr. King raised this inquiry as he looked across a nation divided by race, poverty, and war. He saw a choice for America: either continue down a path of division and chaos or commit to building a true community founded on justice, equity, and love.
- Tonight, we face similar choices. The election results for the majority of us feels like a setback; a reminder of how far we still have to go in creating a just and equitable society. In times like these, we can act out in anger or withdraw in disappointment.
- From a Biblical perspective, there were times when God's people faced similar challenges – when they found themselves under leaders who did not follow God's instructions and who worked against their well-being. How does God expect us to respond in such times?
